

All Saints



All Saints Church Staplehurst, stands on the top of the hill in the centre of the village and is often referred to as the “**Church on the hill**”.

The church was built around 1100 (the south door dating from 1050) to serve the growing community around Maidstone.

Youth Ministry

MiniSaints is a church toddler group for 0 to 5 years that meets on Thursday afternoons from 1.30pm until 3.00pm in the Parish Room.

SuperSaints for 3 to 8 years, meet during the 10am service on the 2nd and 4th Sundays during term time. Basic learning of the Bible through stories, songs etc. Have fun colouring and making things.

Explorers for 8 to 11 years, meet in the Parish Room on a Thursday between 4.30 pm and 5.30pm during term time. The group starts with games and then learn about the Bible and Church life.

The Cru, also meet on Thursdays; this is for 11-15 year olds, again only during term time. We have fun evenings including videos, quizzes and outings. 7.30pm till 8.30pm at 5, Oliver Road.

A.S.C normally meet 2nd and 4th Sundays in the month from 7.30 p.m. This is for those 15 and over and includes discussions, quizzes, playing snooker, table tennis etc. Also they plan our youth service.
